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IMF alerts on rising global debt, predicts over c.USD 100.0 tn owed by year-end

The International Monetary Fund (IMF) warns that global public debt will exceed c.USD 100.0 tn by year-end, reaching c.93.0% of global GDP. The IMF cautions that sustained debt increases could lead to debt distress and potential financial crises. It highlights that rising debt in major economies, such as the U.S., can negatively impact nations working to reduce their debt.

The pandemic and geopolitical events have exacerbated budget deficits, with aging populations and investments in green initiatives further straining fiscal policies. The IMF suggests that countries need to tighten fiscal policies by 3% to 4.5% of GDP to stabilize their debt ratios, warning that delays could make necessary adjustments larger and riskier. The report emphasizes prioritizing cuts to subsidies to protect productive investment.

India retail inflation soars to c.5.5%, driven by surging food prices

India's retail inflation rose to a nine-month high of c.5.5% in September, up from c.3.7% in August, driven primarily by increased food prices. Food inflation saw a significant jump to c.9.2%, compared to c.5.7% the previous month, reflecting ongoing challenges from last year's uneven monsoon rains, which kept food prices elevated.


In early October, the RBI held its benchmark repo rate steady at c.6.5%, indicating that any interest rate cuts might be delayed. The unexpected rise in inflation for September suggests the RBI will adopt a cautious approach moving forward. However, the anticipation of winter crop arrivals is expected to ease some of the price pressures. This uptick in inflation could lead the RBI to postpone any potential rate cuts until 2025, highlighting the delicate balance policymakers must maintain in addressing inflation while supporting economic growth.

India's women T20 World Cup journey cut short in group stage exit

India's campaign in the ICC Women's T20 World Cup 2024 ended in disappointment, marking their first group-stage exit in eight years. A narrow nine-run defeat to Australia sealed their fate, compounded by New Zealand's victory over Pakistan, which left India third in Group A. This is a stark contrast to their recent success, having reached the semifinals in the last three tournaments, including the Final in 2020.

The tournament began poorly with a 52-run loss to New Zealand, but India bounced back with a vital win against Pakistan and an impressive 82-run victory over Sri Lanka. However, despite Harmanpreet Kaur's unbeaten 54 against Australia, the team fell short. As they reflect on this setback, India aims to learn from their experiences and address their weaknesses in preparation for the upcoming 50-over World Cup, hoping to emerge stronger in future competitions.




