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India's services PMI hits 10 month high at 60.4 in June

India's services sector grew at the fastest pace in ten months in June, with the HSBC India Services PMI rising to 60.4 from 58.8 in May. This marked the 37th straight month of expansion, supported by strong domestic demand and a rise in new export orders, particularly from Asia, Europe, and the U.S. Business sentiment stayed positive, with firms expecting further growth in the year ahead. Employment rose for a third month, though hiring momentum slowed slightly compared to May.

Input cost inflation eased to a ten-month low, helping firms maintain margins despite increasing selling prices. The finance and insurance segment led growth, while real estate and business services lagged. Overall, the data points to a resilient and expanding services sector, which continues to play a key role in supporting India's broader economic recovery and growth momentum.

RBI's forex reserves rises by USD 4.8 bn to USD 702.8 bn

India's foreign exchange reserves rose by USD 4.8bn to USD 702.7bn for the week ended June 27, marking the second time since Sept-2024 that reserves have crossed the USD 700bn mark. The increase was mainly driven by a USD 5.1bn rise in foreign currency assets, which form the largest component of reserves. This suggests active RBI intervention to build buffers amid global uncertainties and stable domestic currency conditions. The forex reserves had touched an all-time high of USD 704.9 bn in end-September 2024.

Gold reserves, in contrast, fell by USD 1.2bn during the same week. Meanwhile, Special Drawing Rights increased by USD 158mn. The rise in reserves strengthens India's external position, offering a cushion against global shocks and supporting overall macroeconomic stability.

Divyanshi Bhowmick wins historic U-15 gold at Asian Youth TT Championship

India's Divyanshi Bhowmick won the gold medal in the women's singles U-15 category at the 2025 Asian Youth Table Tennis Championships held in Tashkent, Uzbekistan. The 14-year-old defeated China's Zhu Qihi by 4-2 in the final, becoming the only second Indian to win an individual gold at the event after Sujay Ghorpade in 1986. Seeded second, Divyanshi had earlier overcome China's Liu Ziling in the semi-finals and compatriot Yashaswini Ghorpade in the quarter-finals.

Her victory ended a long wait for India in the singles category at this prestigious championship. With her impressive performance, Divyanshi also secured a spot at the ITTF World Youth Championships 2025, scheduled to take place in November in Helsingborg, Sweden. The tournament witnessed strong performances from Indian paddlers across categories, but Divyanshi's gold stood out as a historic milestone.
